

- If you are living abroad, please provide a valid Email address and phone number. - If there is a person in Japan who can receive the property or contact the police on your behalf, please provide his/her

Submit "The Lost Property Report" at a police station or a police box.


- "The Lost Property Report" is a document that you file at the police station. This report is not a document to prove that an item of property has been lost.

- Searches and investigations will not be conducted based on "The Lost Property Report". You will be informed only when the item indicated on the report has been found.

The found property will be retained at the police station for 3 months from the day the property is reported to the police. During this period, the police will make post notices as well as inquiries to the relevant entities and business operators so that the owner of the lost property may know his/her

* Items such as umbrellas and clothing may either be sold or disposed of if the owner is not found within 2 weeks from the day of posting notices.

If you happen to recover the property after making a Lost Property Report, please promptly communicate the incidence to the police station



If you are living abroad , please provide a valid Email address and phone number after you leave Japan.

You will be given a copy of the "The Receipt of Found Property" which is filed at the police. It indicates the period during which you are entitled to the ownership in case the property cannot be returned to the owner.

Please keep this receipt as it will be required to receive the found property after you acquire its ownership.

The found property will be retained at the police station for 3 months from the day the property is reported to the police. During this period, the police will post notices as well as make inquiries to the relevant entities and business operators so that the owner of the lost property will know his/her property has been recovered.

* Items such as umbrellas or clothing may either be sold or disposed of if the owner is not found within 2 weeks from the day of posting notices.
